The **University Partnership Title IV-E Child Welfare Training Program** (UPP) is designed to prepare social work students to enter the field of child welfare. Participants are chosen annually through a competitive application process. BSSW, MSW-ASAP or MSW II students are encouraged to apply.

## Key Benefits

- A \$5,000 financial incentive for those who work in Ohio public child welfare after completing the program
- Specialized course work and field practicum in child welfare during the year prior to graduation
- “Fast-tracking” to full-time employment in child welfare upon graduation
- Individualized attention and mentoring by UPP coordinator and field instructors
- Early exposure and networking in the field of child welfare

- SWK 5008: *Child Welfare II*
- SWK 7630: *Integrative Seminar I on Child and Youth (MSW ASAP and MSW II students only)*
- SWK 7631: *Integrative Seminar II on Child and Youth Services (MSW ASAP and MSW II students only)*
- *Bi-Weekly child welfare field placement seminars for BSSW students (SWK 4189). MSW students attend the seminar but do not register.*
- *Field placement in a public children service agency in Ohio (BSSW/SWK 4189 or MSW/SWK 7189)*
