

# **Out-of-State Student Requirements**

### 1. Field Placement:

- Out-of-state students will be **required** to be actively involved in the placement process.
  - o Students should begin identifying agencies for potential placement upon admission.
  - o The semester prior to the start of field, student will complete the field application.
  - Student will then begin outreach to agencies working closely with the field coordinator until placement is achieved.

## 2. Working Part/Full-Time in Addition to Field:

- Students should <u>expect</u> to do field hours over two to three workdays during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:00AM-5:00PM). Very few agencies have evening and weekend hours available.
  - o Employed students must arrange their work schedules to accommodate field.
  - o If you want to complete your field placement at your place of employment, please review the Employment Based Placement Policy.

## 3. Supervision Requirements

- Students are required to receive a minimum of one hour of supervision per week
- Supervision must be provided by someone with an MSW and 2 years post-degree experience
- If an agency does not have an MSW on staff, alternative supervision arrangements may be available. Please discuss this with the online field coordinator as soon as possible.
